

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STITCH COUNT 15 high x 13 wide

DESIGN AREA 14 HPI (28-count evenweave) – 2.5x2.5cm (1x1in)

This design was stitched using DMC stranded cotton

How to make your hanging...

1. Cut our stitched piece leaving a 1.5cm (½in) seam allowance all the way around.
2. Cut a coordinating backing fabric to the same size, using your cut-out stitched piece as a template.
3. Fold your ribbon or cord in half to create a loop. Ours uses cord made with the Kreinik Custom Corder. Pin the ends of your cord at the top of the stitched piece, making sure the loop lies downwards.
4. Pin together front and back pieces with right sides facing and the loop tucked inside. Machine- or hand-stitch with a 1cm (¼in) seam allowance, leaving a small gap at the bottom. Turn through and press.
5. Fill your decoration firmly with wadding, then slip stitch the gap closed for a neat finish.
